- **Sell Ironwood Golf Course.** Are you happy that the city owns a golf course that is so run down it needs hundreds of thousands of dollars to bring it up to par? It is also projected to lose \$300,000 per year.
- **Fix the transgender bathroom ordinance.** Finally, were you notified in advance that your city commission, led by Mayoral candidate Craig Lowe, wanted to make a change in a city ordinance that would allow any man the legal right to enter any public women's room by merely declaring an "inner sense" of being a woman? No, you found out at the last minute and it was approved late at night over an uproar of public protest. Did you like being characterized as a bigot or a homophobe for being concerned about the safety of women and children?
